

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Before using this product read the entire label.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Mode of Action: This product is a liquid non-selective, general herbicide which is designed to be used where control of all vegetation is desired. It produces rapid top killing of all succulent vegetation. Translocation and root absorption produces effective root kill of weeds and provides long term control.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

For easy application and better penetration dilute 1 gallon of herbicide to 10 gallons of water and apply as directed below. Sufficient moisture from rainfall or artificial means is necessary after treatment to carry the chemical into the root of the weeds. This herbicide can either be sprayed or sprinkled on. If sprayed, direct the spray to the soil at the base of the weeds and adjust for coarse spray to prevent drifting.

ANNUAL WEEDS AND GRASS: Such as Crabgrass, Foxtail, Ryegrass, Broomgrass, Lambsquarter, and similar weeds. Use 11 gallons of diluted solution per 825 sq. ft.

PERENNIAL WEEDS AND GRASSES: Such as Smooth Broome, Quackgrass, Bluegrass, Purple Top, Dandelion, Goldenrod, Wild Carrot, and similar weeds. Use 11 gallons of the diluted herbicide per 500 sq. ft.

HARD TO KILL PERENNIALS: Such as Johnson Grass, Bermuda Grass, Dallisgrass, Nutgrass, Saltgrass, Dogbane, Horsetail, Bracken Fern, and similar weeds. Use 11 gallons of the diluted herbicide per 200 sq. ft. Use the higher levels of dosage on absorptive soils. Do not exceed 100 gallons of concentrate per acre per year.

RETREATMENT:

11 gallons of the diluted herbicide per 825 sq. ft. when annual weeds and grasses reappear.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling, reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
