**INDOORS FOR CONTROL OF RESIDENTIAL AND INDUSTRIAL INSECTS**  
**House Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths:** Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Using a conventional mechanical or compressed air spraying or fogging equipment apply as a fog or fine mist directing the spray toward the upper portions of the room and toward wind jacks and other light sources which attract these insects. Thoroughly fill the area with mist using 1 to 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least 10 minutes. Ventilate after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as needed.

Direct the spray at these insects when possible. Spray thorough hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night.

**Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants. Repeat as necessary.

**Cockroaches, Sowbugs, Boxelder Bugs, Centipedes, Crickets, Grain Mites, Spiders:** Apply as a coarse droplet spray directly on crevices and other hiding places along baseboards, around the base and under pallets. Spray thoroughly contacting insects directly with. Spray badly infested areas daily. In other areas repeat treatments when reinfestation occurs.

**INDOORS HOUSE PLANTS AND GREENHOUSES AND ORNAMENTALS:** For control of **Aphids, Two-Spotted Spider Mites, Plantlice, Aralia, Christmas Cherry, Chrysanthemum, Cineraria, Dffenbachia, Ficus, Lantana, Weathr, Bella Palm, Petunia, Rose, Snapdragon, Azalea, Begonia, Zinnia.** Direct the spray so that upper and lower surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat as necessary.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Containers should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried away from water supplies. Reseal container and offer for reconditioning or triple rinse for equipment recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill or burn.
