The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are printed, make the following changes:

1. For all above products, add or revise the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD statement to be consistent with requirements in the Permethrin Standard:

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

(The last sentence may be omitted from pressurized containers.)

2. Delete petroleum distillate and aromatic petroleum hydrocarbons as active ingredients from registrations 11474-35, 36, and 37. Include the percentages of those ingredients as part of the inert ingredient total.
3. For registration 11474-35, change the statements to read "Foods should be removed or covered before treatment. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse."

INDOORS: FOR CONTROL OF RESIDENTIAL AND INDUSTRIAL INSECTS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths.

Close doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Using a conventional mechanical or compressed air spraying or fogging equipment. Apply as a fog or fine mist, directing the spray toward the upper portions of the room and toward windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Thoroughly fill the area with mist using 1/2 to 1 ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least 10 minutes. Vacate after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as needed.

Direct the spray at these insects when possible. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night.

"Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system."

Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the pesticide registered under EPA Reg. No. 11474-37

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry on ants when possible. Repeat as needed. Cockroaches, Sawflies, Boxelder Beetles, Earwigs, Grain Mites, Spiders: Spray directed into cracks and crevices along baseboards, round the base of doors. Spray thoroughly contacting insects when possible. Spray badly infested areas repeat treatments twice weekly or more often.

INDOORS AND OUTDOORS: GREENHOUSES AND ORNAMENTS: Control of: Aphids, Two-Spotted Spider Mites, Violets, Aralia, Christmas Cherry, Dillenia, Fuschia, Gloxinia, Ivy, Palm, Petunia, Snapdragon, Azalea, etc.

Direct the spray so that upper and lower surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth. Repeat treatment as necessary. Wait 24 hours before airing when air is still.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL
