The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The Disposal Statements must be revised because this product does not qualify as a homeowner product. You must use the container disposal statements from your last stamped label, which read as follows:

Container Disposal. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

You must add a pesticide disposal statement as follows:

Pesticide Disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

SPACE AND CONTACT SPRAY: For control of accessible exposed stages of silverfish, crickets, roaches, spiders scorpions, clover mites, cheese mites, earwigs, and ants, first using equipment which can deliver a pin spray, direct spray into all cracks and crevices in woodwork, walls, floors, underneath sinks, behind pipes and in all places where these insects are known to seek shetter. Contact as many insects as possible, spray directly all ants trails. Do not allow spray to contact stored foud.
