The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. You must add the statement - **CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISTILLATE** - as a substatement to the ingredient statement.
2. Under the Precautionary Statement section, the "Hazards to Humans" section requires that you indicate the precaution to be taken to avoid injury or damage and to indicate the appropriate first aid statement for the hazard. As new labels are prepared, modify this precaution in accordance with 40 CFR 156.10(h)(2)(i). The following may serve as an example.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- 3. Under PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS you must modify the second paragraph to include the statements - Foods should be removed or covered before treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using.
4. Use this product's last accepted label, dated September 17, 1985, as a reference to restore the asterisk under the INGREDIENT STATEMENT, to restore the word - additional - in the statement under the word - CAUTION; and to correct and careful, edit the current label text for typographical errors as well as for spelling and word usage.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**SPACE SPRAY:** For rapid control of gnats, flying moths, sand flies, wasps, windows and shut off ventilating machine adjusted to deliver a fine mist in upper portions of the room to fill the to 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space ventilate before reoccupying. Keep closed after treating. Repeat application when necessary.  
**SURFACE APPLICATION:** To control ants, and spiders. Apply as a coarse wet mist in locations where these insects may hide in cabinets, shelves, sinks, door and window drains and in dark corners and into cracks with the spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Against ant infestation, treat shelves, spray ant runs, trails, baseboards, thresholds, entry, and treat nests liberally. Repeat in controlling fleas and Brown Dog Fleas. Application toward the lower wall portion and floors of infested areas. Animal cages should also be sprayed.

To control bedbugs effectively, apply to and bottoms of mattresses, springs, and folds. Spray springs and frame cracks and lock joints. Treat walls, closets and bedroom furniture, paying attention to protect bedbug hiding and for most effective control of clothing. Remove infested articles from storage if possible, air several hours in direct sunlight, empty chests, closets, bureaus and suitcases, cracks, joints and crevices.

After airing, infested articles may be sprayed with nozzle at least 3 feet away from the article, lightly to the seams to avoid possible damage to rugs, carpet and pads, and all other overstuffed furniture. Do not overspray rubber or urethane coated, or plastic. Repeat treatments monthly unless the infestation is not controlled.

To control infestations of granary weevil, grain beetle, confused flour beetle, beetle, cadellies, meal worms, grain moth, Indian meal moth and Mediterranean flour moth: If possible, clean out and destock otherwise, fumigation or other effective method using an approved product intended for use on stored grain. Apply intended spray thoroughly to all surfaces of storage areas and similar food storage areas with cracks, niches, and other hiding places.  
**FOG OR VAPOR SPRAY:** To kill insects named on this label (excepting carpet beetles): Apply using conventional compressed air equipment. Fill the equipment to 6 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space.
