DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To shampoo and kill fleas and ticks, wet the pet's coat with warm water. Starting at the head, work shampoo thoroughly into the hair. Allow the lather to penetrate the fur for five minutes before rinsing. Dry with a towel. The pet will have a clear lustrous coat, free of fleas and ticks. Retreat if infestation occurs, but not more than once every 7 days.
Do not use on animals under 12 weeks old.
Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.
Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a dry place no lower in temperature than 50°F or higher than 120°F.

DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS:

If Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 9-1-1 or an ambulance then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
