STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air.
- If on skin - Wash contaminated skin with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and utensils by keeping them well covered while spraying the area.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply only as specified on the label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Dilutions of this concentrate should be made shortly before use in the quantity needed for the individual application. Water dilutions should not be kept for future use.

TO CONTROL INSECTS ON ANIMALS

SPONGE BATH OR DIP: Dilute this concentrate at a rate of 1 fluid ounce in 23 fluid ounces of water (2 tablespoons of concentrate in 2 3/4 cups of water) or 6 fluid ounces (12 tablespoons) in 1 gallon of water.

For rapid control of ticks, fleas and lice on cats and dogs, sponge solution on thoroughly wetting skin over entire animal or dip the animal. Do not rinse; allow solution to remain on animal. In cases of heavy tick infestations on long-haired cats or dogs, dilute 1 fluid ounce of concentrate to 11 fluid ounces of water (2 tablespoons of concentrate in 1 1/4 cups of water) or 12 fluid ounces (24 tablespoons) of concentrate in one gallon of water.

MIST SPRAY: Dilute this concentrate at the rate of 7 fluid ounces in 1 gallon of water or 1 fluid ounce of concentrate in 18 fluid ounces of water.

For rapid control of ticks, fleas and lice using a mist spray. To insure thorough coverage, part the fur by stroking against the lay of the hair as spray is applied. Spray ticks directly. Apply to moisten the fur lightly. To control spinose ear ticks and ear mites, syringe the ears with a few drops of this dilution so that it can penetrate the wax down to the surrounding tissues. Repeat treatment once twice at 2 to 3 day intervals as necessary.
