APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS:

Food processing plants and warehouses, bakeries, beverage plants, restaurants, supermarkets, meat and poultry processing plants, hotels, motels, hospitals, and schools.

Crack and Crevice Treatment Only:

Using a bulbous duster apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes or switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where cockroaches, ants, silverfish, spiders, boxelder bugs, and crickets hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

NON-FOOD AREAS:

Homes, institutions, hospitals, office buildings, hotels, motels, theaters, schools, warehouses, truck trailers and railroad cars: To control crawling insects such as ants, cockroaches, silverfish, firebrats, spiders, boxelder bugs, fleas, lice, and fleas in animal quarters: distribute Drione at the rate of 2 ounces per 100 square feet of surface area. Apply a continuous visible film underneath and behind stairs, refrigerators and appliances. Treat on, around and behind moldings, shelving, baseboards, pipe openings, cracks, crevices, and other areas where insects hide. For severe infestations, apply Drione behind cabinets and walls, in crawl spaces and attics at the rate of 16 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area. Repeat treatment as necessary.

STORED PRODUCT PESTS:

To aid in the control of cadellies, cheese mites, cigarette beetles, dark meal worms, drugstore beetles, grain mites, g. beetles, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles and yellow elevators and granaries. Clean up waste materials, dust, etc. Thoroughly treat floors, walls and other surfaces in bins, s. Apply into cracks and crevices and other difficult to reach hide.

BEES AND WASPS:

It is generally advisable to treat wasp and bee nests in the less active and have returned to the nest. Using hand or pole means, with extension tubes if necessary, thoroughly dust surrounding areas where insects alight. Nests in wall voids with your ear against the wall. Drill a hole in the area, blow ground wasps, dust entrance and surrounding areas. SEWER TREATMENTS:

DRYWOOD TERMITES

To protect against entrance, using an electric or hand operated Drione through an entry, e.g. crawl hole into attic and crawl s 1 pound per 1000 square feet of floor area. All vents and blo should be closed. All wood surfaces should be covered. In ca probe to locate galleries and drill holes to inject Drione into heavy infestation has already developed, fumigation should b

FLEAS: DOGS AND CATS

Liberal apply powder to the animal. Rubbing thoroughly to and include the underbody, legs, feet and the base of the tail. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at the rate of one ounce infested lawns, basements, and crawl spaces should be dusted 1000 square feet. Repeat as necessary.
