The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) or FIFRA sec.4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- Based on the acute toxicity profile of the referenced product, EPA Reg. No. 4816-353, make the following label changes:
 - Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals to read:

Harmful is absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Containers larger than one pound may not be used or stored in food handling establishments.

b. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get

medical attention.

Flush with plenty of water. Call a IF IN EYES: physician if irritation persists.

c. Add a Note to Physician section to the label as follows:

3. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to read as follows:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater or rinsate.

4. Under the directions for use add the following statement:

Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not apply this product in patient rooms while occupied or any rooms while occupied by the elderly or infirm.

5. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
