1. Within the First aid claim, change the "If Swallowed" statement and corresponding language to:

"IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

Refer to Page 5 Section G of PR Notice 2001-1 for those products containing Petroleum distillates in excess of 10%.

2. Under the subsection entitled "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN" insert the statement: "Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."
