d. Revise the instructions under "Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks" to reflect spot spraying of animal sleeping quarters, closets, upholstered furniture, and floor areas. Delete instructions for coarse cone or fan spray, treating entire floor and application rate of 1 gallon to 750 sq ft. These instructions are inappropriate for a product applied with a pump spray head to localized areas.

3. The lower limits for the active ingredients listed on the Confidential Statement of Formula all fall below the label claim. They must be revised upwards to equal or exceed the label claim.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFPA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

If swallowed: Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting give victim one to two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin: Wash contaminated skin with soap and water. If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

Note to physician: solvent present aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is antidotal. PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine.
