- For food handling establishments can imply use in (1) the home, (2) schools, (3) institutional Meat and Poultry Plants, (4) restaurants, (5) the statement "Not for use in (1) (2) (3) and (4) only," or submit an application to USDA requesting use in those areas. If granted you can then indicate on the label that the product can be used in those areas.
- For the statement "Do not use in edible product areas . . ." with the following exceptions:

to include all food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or prepared for use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed for use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Nonfood areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floors leading to sewers, entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING** unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting give victim one to two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

If on Skin: Wash contaminated skin with soap and water.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

Note to physician: Solvent present aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of mist and contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of food feed products, and utensils.

Do not use on household pets or humans. Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not store or use near heat or open flame.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of reach of lakes, streams, and ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use as space spray. For spot application only. Do not use in edible product areas of federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

Apply with enclosed pump sprayers as indicated below.

Do not use this product in or on electric equipment due to possibility of shock hazards.

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

SERVING AREAS-SPOT TREATMENT

Facilities where food are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held, apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction, and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. **DO NOT APPLY WHEN FACILITY IS IN OPERATION OR FOODS ARE EXPOSED.**

IN NON-FOOD AREAS:
RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS AND AROUND HOMES:
Includes garbage rooms, sewers/entries and vestibule machine rooms, boiler room storage (after canning or bottling), roaches, ants, waterbugs, silverfish, etc. apply to baseboard areas around and beneath sinks, lockers, areas where insects hide or thieve. Repeat treatment as required.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADDITIONAL USES:
Carpet beetles, fleas, etc. Spray carpeting and rug. Mix floor and baseboards. Spray and infested areas. Wash bedding.

Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Before treatment, Pet bedding placed with fresh bedding in quarters, closets, apply directed attention to seams and under furniture. Spot treat and ticks and flea infested areas. Pets must be treated with a product labeled for use on animals. Repeat as necessary. **DO NOT FORMULATE.**

House flies, Mosquitoes, etc. Outdoors: For outdoor use of annoyance from this insects, screens, doors, window frames may enter the room. Also treat porches, in garages, insects alight or congregate. Fleas, Chiggers, Ants, Outdoor infestation of these insects on and bushy non crop areas. Avoid spraying desirable plants and fruit trees. Repeat as required.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a closed container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Dispose in several layers of newspaper. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Wash thoroughly before discarding.
