The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

EPA Registration No. 11474-80:

1. To remove your product from scope of the Worker Protection Standard add the following after the paragraph "To control listed insects.....": "Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in interior plantscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns and grounds."
2. Revise Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals as follows:

Causes skin irritation and moderate eye irritation. Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash with soap and water before handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Contains petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. LAWN FLEA CONTROL:

To kill fleas harboring in lawns use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Place required amount of concentrate in sprayer jar (see chart below) and spray as recommended. For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamental and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants.

Not for use on turf or plants being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Keep pet and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should be also treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this application.
