Dear Mr. Mackson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label has been enclosed for your records.

1. Under the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section, delete the statements "Contains petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard." Move the statement "Avoid ... feedstuffs" to the "Directions for Use" section. Revise the statement "Wash with soap and water before handling" to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
2. Because your product contains petroleum distillate, please revise the "IF SWALLOWED" section of your "First Aid" statements to read:

"Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."
3. Either delete the phrase "...or as needed throughout the growing season...crop" or indicate a time period for retreatment based on the residual efficacy of your product.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Not for use on turf or plants being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

LAWN FLEA CONTROL:

To kill fleas harboring in lawns use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Place required amount of concentrate in sprayer jar (see chart below) and spray as recommended. For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamental and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding areas should also be treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this application.

TO CONTROL THE FOLLOWING INSECTS: Alfalfa Caterpillar, Alfalfa Looper, Aphid, Armyworm, Artichoke Plume Moth, Beet Armyworm, Buckthorn Aphid, Cabbage Looper, Carrot Weevil, Celery Looper, Chinch Bug, Colorado Potato Beetle, Corn Earworm, Corn Rootworm (adults), Cowpea Curculio, Cucumber Beetle (adults) - spotted and striped, Cutworm, Diamondback Moth, European Corn Borer, Flea Beetle, Grasshopper, Green Cloverworm, Imported Cabbageworm, Leafhopper, Looper, Lygus Bug, Mexican Bean Beetle, Painted Lady Caterpillar, Pea Aphid, Pea Weevil, Pepper Weevil, Pickleworm, Potato Leafhopper, Potato Psyllid, Potato Tuberworm, Rindworm, Saltmarsh Caterpillar, Sap Beetle, Southwestern Corn Borer, Squash Bug, Squash Vine Borer, Stalk Borer, Stink Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Tobacco Hornworm, Tomato Fruitworm, Tomato Hornworm, Tomato Pinworm, Vegetable Leafminer, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Western Bean Cutworm, and Whitefly.

To control listed insects, apply the spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment weekly or as needed throughout the growing season up to days of harvest given for each crop.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use only intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being used in interior landscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns and grounds.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS: Mix EVER-SECT III Concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of 2 fluid ounces per gallon of water to control on contact ants, cockroaches (including German and Asian cockroaches), crickets, palmetto bugs, sowbugs, spiders, and ticks. Use at the rate of 1 gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

BUILDING PERIMETER TREATMENT: To help prevent infestations of buildings by ants, centipedes, crickets, sowbugs (pillbugs), and spiders, treat a 12-18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance. Use 16 fluid ounces of concentrate per gallon of water and apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 square feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright in a cool, dry place. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS:

If Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
