Dear Mr. Mackson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label has been enclosed for your records.

- 1. Under the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section, delete the statements "Avoid contact with...if irritation persists." Move the statement "Avoid ... feedstuffs" to the "Directions for Use" section. Add the following statements to this section: "Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."
- 2. Either delete the phrase "...or as needed throughout the growing season...crop" or indicate a time period for retreatment based on the residual efficacy of your product.

Under the Federal Insecticide. Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, for the pasticide registered under EPA Reg. No.

11474-81

Fruitworm, Tomato Hornworm, Tomato Pinworm, Vegetable Leafminer, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Western Bean Cutworm, and Whitefly.

To control listed insects, apply the spray with either a pump sprayer or a compressed air sprayer (tank or mechanical) to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment weeldy or as needed throughout the growing season up to days of harvest given for each crop.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in interior plantscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or ongolf courses or lawns and grounds.

NOTE: This is a ready to use product.

FIRST AID:

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment,

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
