DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Restricted Use Pesticide

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

Industrial Plants, Manufacturing Plants, and Food Processing Plants.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls; along

baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas and Ticks: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as, nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames; and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE

To Kill Ants, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Dermestids, Earwigs, Fleas, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, and Ticks: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between elements of construction; between equipment and floors; openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls; equipment legs and places where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

OUTDOORS: Use only at listed sites.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing numbers from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to exposed surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area place. Keep container closed.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
