DIRECTIONS FOR USE.
General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CONTROL: Ants, Chinch Bugs, Fleas, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths), Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Pillbugs, Certain White Grubs, and Hyperodes (Turfgrass) Weevils Infesting Home Lawns and Other Ornamental Turf Areas, spread evenly at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1000 square feet. Immediately after application, water lawn using 30 gallons per 1000 square feet. For Chinch Bug control consult your local state Agricultural Extension Agent as to the exact timing for best application schedule.
