## DIRECTIONS SHOCK TRET FOR ALGAE IN NON STABILIZED POOLS

Use one ounce Shock Tret per 500 Gallons of water. Scatter amount required over the entire water surface area, concentrating on those areas where the algae is seen to be growing. The following day brush walls and bottom to remove dead algae and then vacuum the pool. Chlorine residual should be below 2ppm before swimmers enter pool. Adjust pH to 7.2 to 7.6 range.

Shock Tret for algae in stabilized pools or those using concentrated chlorine, tablets or granular, such as our Super 60 or Super 90.
