Although somewhat slower acting than some other selective weed killers, POST-MERGER is preferable, because of this very fact, so as to minimize injuring the turf.

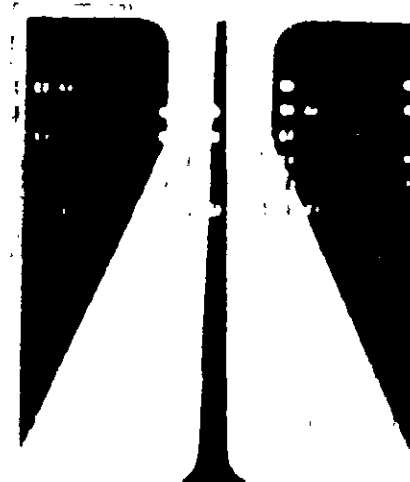
It has been demonstrated that POST-MERGER will control the following weeds:

IMPORTANT

Mow lawn first. Do not apply if rain is forecast within 24 hours, and do not sprinkle for 24 hours following application. Apply when weeds are young, as in Spring or Fall. Do not apply during drought or very hot weather conditions. Do not use on newly seeded areas, or if you want clover in the lawn. Reseed, or replace bare spots 3 to 4 weeks after treatment.

CAUTION

Do not use POST-MERGER on St. Augustine, Carpet buffalo, dichondra, and bent grasses. These grasses may show sensitivity.

DIRECTIONS

Established Grasses: Mix 3 oz. POST-MERGER in 4 gals. water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. Use 7 pints POST-MERGER in 40 gals. water to treat 1 acre.

CAREFULLY CLEAN SPRAYERS!

Immediately after use flush thoroughly with water. Fill tank with a solution of 1 qt. household ammonia for every 25 gals. of water volume. Spray a small amount through the hose and nozzle — keep the remainder in sprayer 18 to 24 hours. Now, drain tank and flush several times with clear water for tank, hose and nozzle.
