DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label. **ENTRY RESTRICTIONS:** Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.

Superior No. 402 is recommended for the control of weeds in noncrop industrial sites such as railroad, highway and pipeline rights-of-way, petroleum tank farms, lumber yards, storage areas and industrial plant sites. Not to be used in any recreational areas or in or around homes.

Superior No. 402 may be applied by power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, knapsack sprayers or ordinary sprinklers. Before spraying, calibrate equipment to uniformly apply the product. Use a fixed boom power sprayer properly calibrated to a constant speed and rate of delivery. For application with a hand-gun sprayer, be careful to obtain even distribution of the product to the soil. Do not apply when ground is frozen. Do not apply through any type of irrigation system.

Apply as a preemergence or early postemergence spray when weeds are actively germinating or growing, or prior to this period. Adequate control is possible when the vegetation is short or just after mowing. Superior No. 402 is absorbed through the roots. Rainfall or thorough watering following application is required to activate Superior No. 402. The effectiveness and length of time that control will last will depend on type of soil, amount of rain and other conditions.

For treating 1000 square feet, under ordinary conditions, dilute 3 to 6 gallons of Superior No. 402 with sufficient water to give good coverage. For application use a sprayer that will produce a coarse wet spray and that will apply the solutions evenly over the entire area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store product in original container only. Product will freeze at temperatures below 32°F. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer to recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Superior No. 402 is a water soluble liquid to be mixed in water and applied for weed control in noncrop and industrial sites. After mixing with water, Superior No. 402 is non-flammable, non-volatile and non-corrosive to metals, except aluminum. Use with aluminum spray nozzles or equipment is not recommended. Thoroughly clean all mixing and spray equipment with several changes of water, or water and a commercial cleaner, after removing nozzle tips and screens (clean these parts separately). Injury to or loss of desirable trees or other plants may result if Superior No. 402 is applied or if equipment is drained or flushed on or near desirable trees or other plants, on areas where their roots may extend, or in locations where the chemical may be washed or moved into contact with their roots.
