

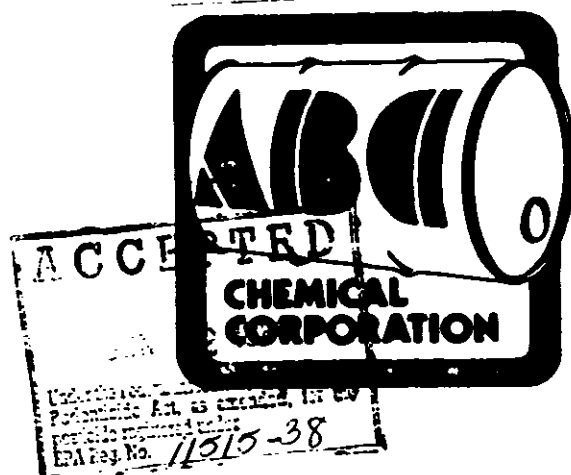

DANGER

Statement of Practical Treatment:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi. For best results, use #418 with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when the solution become visibly dirty.

NO RINSE REQUIRED.
For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is required.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
PROHIBITIONS
