

# P/P INSECTICIDE No. 7

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### CAUTION

For Use in Homes and Non-Food Areas of Commercial Buildings: Warehouses, Theatres, Office Buildings, Schools, Hotels, Restaurants, Kitchens, and Food Processing Facilities.

Controls flies, mosquitoes, roaches, ants, small flying moths, carpet beetles, grubs, bedbugs, silverfish, wasps, spiders, ticks, centipedes, and millipedes. Contents of this can will completely treat 75,000 cubic feet (75 rooms, 10 x 10 x 10) for flies and mosquitoes.

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate utensils, food, water or foodstuffs. If swallowed call a physician immediately. Do not use in the edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Do not spray directly on skin or on animals. Remove birds and pets and cover fish bowls and aquaria before spraying. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate after treatment is complete. When used as a residual spray, do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry. Do not apply to areas which will be contacted frequently by children and pets.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

##### General Classification

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS, WASPS, HORNETS AND GNATS** - release spray upward and in all directions into air of closed room, about 4 to 6 seconds for every 1,000 cubic feet. After 15 minutes, doors and windows may be opened. To control wasps and hornets in nests, spray nests directly, at night.

**ROACHES, BEDBUGS, SILVERFISH, ANTS, TICKS, CENTIPEDES AND MILLIPEDES** - Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray directly on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.  
**TICKS:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet's beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. **DO NOT TREAT PET WITH THIS PRODUCT.**

**BEDBUGS:** Spray all parts of bed framing thoroughly, holding can about 4 feet away. For mattresses spray seams and tufts. Do not spray general surface of mattress. Air bedding, until completely dry, at least 4 hours before using. Repeat if necessary.

**CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES:** Hold can at least 4 feet away, and spray articles thoroughly, with special attention to folds and seams. Spray inside closets or containers where articles are to be stored. Repeat monthly, if articles are not stored in moth tight containers.

**OUTDOOR USE ON FLYING INSECTS:** Spray into grass and shrubbery (about 1 foot above ground), in immediate area to be occupied. Hold can about 4 feet away from vegetation being sprayed. Similarly, spray around patios, barbecue pits, picnic tables, and other outdoor areas, when the air is quiet. Frequent repeated applications may be necessary, depending on weather conditions.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with amended registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Prior to releasing the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling, incorporate the following revisions into the finished labeling and submit five copies for our records.

1. Delete the heading "GENERAL CLASSIFICATION" as this chemical/application site has not yet been classified.
2. Revise the first sentence of the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" as follows:  
"This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife."
3. Insert the following as the first sentence of the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."
