

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION**

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE - Store in original container in a cool, dry place.
DISPOSAL - Do not discharge contents into sewer. Dispose of empty container as directed.

This product will kill House Flies, Mosquitoes, Carpet Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Spiders, Wasps, Pill Bugs, Crickets and Silverfish.

Aids in the control of Cockroaches.

Once exposed to fog, insects and animals will die almost immediately and debris should be eliminated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Personnel entering away from fumigation should wear a respirator. One unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before reentry.

TO OPERATE VALVE - To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing 2-3 layers of newspaper or paper under fogger. Unhook button and keep button depressed for four hours before releasing it. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.
