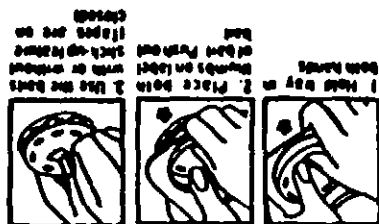

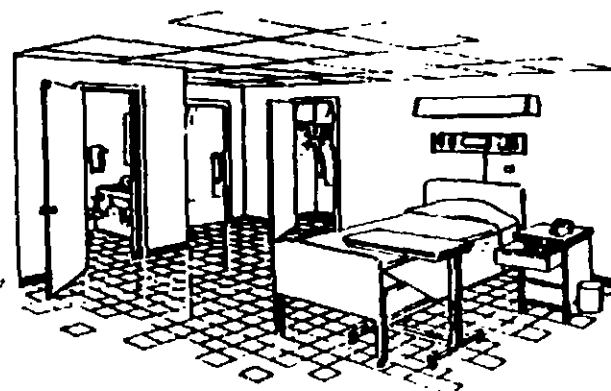
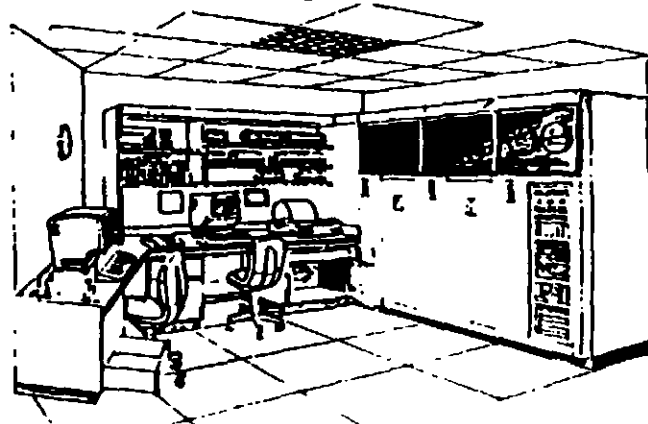

Place them near walls on shelves under sinks refrigerators and in storage areas where roaches are seen. Use 4-6 Baits per 100 square feet of surface to be treated more if infestation is great. Replace as necessary to maintain control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENTS

STORAGE: Store in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Wrap container and put in trash collection.
