BACK PANEL

A heavy duty commercial formula insecticide for Commercial, Industrial and Residential Use.

IMPORTANT: Shake well before using.

KILLS: Angoumois Grain Moth, Ants, Cadelle, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Chocolate Moth, Cigarette Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Dermestid Beetles, Drug Store Beetles, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas, Flies, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Grain Mites in exposed adult and larvae stages, Granary Weevils, Hide Beetles, Hornets, Indian Meal Moth, Mediterranean Flour Moth, Merchant Grain Beetles, Millipedes, Mosquitoes, Mud Daubers, Palmetto Bugs, Pillbugs, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Roaches, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Ticks, Wasps, Waterbugs and Yellow Jackets.

Use Pro-Control Inspector for insect infestations in apartments, attics, basements, buses, cabins, campers, commercial buildings, food handling establishments, food processing plants, food storage areas, garages, hospitals*, hotels, houses, kennels, motels, nursing homes, office buildings, railroad cars, restaurants, schools, sheds, ships, storage areas, supermarkets, truck trailers, warehouses, zoos. *Remove patients before using. After treatment ventilate rooms for 30 minutes before returning patients to rooms.

For best results, use Pro-Control Inspector in conjunction with other Pro-Control products for more complete control of insect problems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is designed for either space spray or crack & crevice application.

For space spray use: Wand assembly should be in the downward position.

For crack & crevice use: Wand assembly should be fully extended outward from the can.

Ants, Centipedes, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Millipedes, Palmetto Bugs, Pillbugs, Roaches, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Waterbugs: Place wand tip, approximately 1/2 inch into crack and mist directly, contacting as many

insects as possible. Apply freely in all possible hiding places; behind baseboards, sinks, cabinets, refrigerators, dishwashers, under counters. Move tip along while spraying in long running cracks.

Flying insects: Angoumois Grain Moth, Chocolate Moth, Flies, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Indian Meal Moth, Mediterranean Flour Moth, Mosquitoes: Close all windows and doors and direct spray upward at a rate of 1-3 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. Disperse in all directions. Keep area closed for 15 min. Open and ventilate before reoccupying.

Fleas in buildings: Close all windows and doors. Hold 36 inches above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at as rate of 10 sec. per 100 sq. ft., making sure that all floor and upholstered surfaces are contacted. Repeat treatments after 7 days or as necessary.

Cadelle, Carpet Beetles, Cigarette Beetles, Confused Flour Beetles, Dermestid Beetles, Drug Store Beetles, Grain Mites in exposed adult and larvae stages, Granary Weevils, Hide Beetles, Merchant Grain Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, stored products, cartons, containers, machinery and dark secluded areas. Spray 20 sec. per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Repeat treatment weekly or as necessary. For Carpet Beetles, treat infested areas of carpets, localized areas of floors, baseboards and into cracks and under carpets where these pests may be found. Spray 10-20 sec. per 1000 sq. ft. of floor space.

Mud Daubers, Wasps, Hornets and Yellow Jackets: Spray mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 foot distance. Insects contacted will fly away from fog. Application should be made in late evening while insects are inactive.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store away from heat or open flames in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not remain in enclosed areas after use.
