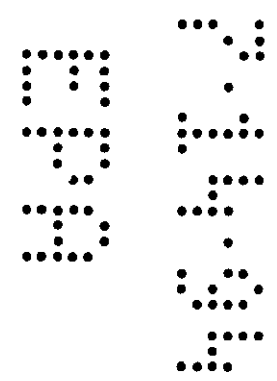

KILLS: Ants, Crickets, ~~Palmetto/Bugs~~, Roaches, Silverfish, and Spiders ~~and/Waterbugs~~.

Use Pro-Control Treatment for Crawling Insects for insect infestations in apartments, attics, basements, ~~boats~~, bottling plants, ~~buses~~, cabins, campers, canning plants, commercial buildings, dairies, food handling establishments, food processing plants, food storage areas, garages, hospitals, hotels, houses, industrial installations, meat packing plants, milling operations, motels, nursing homes, office buildings, ~~railroad/cars~~/ restaurants, schools, sheds, ~~ship/s/holds~~, storage areas, supermarkets, transportation equipment (buses, boats, ships, trains, ~~planes~~, truck trailers) warehouses and animal facilities (Kennels & Zoos).

For best results, use Pro-Control Treatment for Crawling Insects in conjunction with other Pro-Control products for more complete control of insect problems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake Before Using.

To use Pro-Control Treatment for Crawling Insects extend adjustable wand to desired position. Place wand tip approximately 1/2 " into cracks and crevices or void spaces where insects may be harboring, living and breeding. Discharge approximately a one-second spray burst per treatment area. In long running cracks, move tip along the crack at the rate of one linear foot per second while spraying. ~~Repeat/as/necessary/~~

Roaches ~~Palmetto/Bugs~~, (~~Waterbugs~~): Injection into cracks & crevices and void spaces where insects may be harboring, such as openings around pipes and sinks, around and under refrigerators, washing machines, stoves, cabinets, and counters, behind baseboards, and around meter boxes. ~~and/sinks~~. Apply to areas where the insecticide will not be mopped or washed away. Slight foaming action of this formula completely fills tight crevices leaving a long-term insecticide residue. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Apply to ant trails and inject cracks & crevices and voids where ants may be traveling or habiting, such as around doors, window frames, behind electrical switches, outlets and baseboards, and other structural cracks and crevices.

Silverfish, Crickets and Spiders: Treat infested areas ~~and~~ by injecting into cracks & crevices in harborage sites such as baseboards, door frames and bookcases. ~~and/other/harborage/sites~~. Repeat as necessary.

Glass and vinyl tile surfaces may require frequent ~~repeat~~ applications to maintain residual effectiveness.

FOOD/AREAS/OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

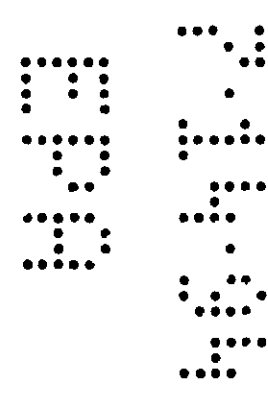
FOOD AREAS-APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY. Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing, preparing and serving areas in facilities such as; bottling plants, canneries, grocery stores, restaurants, bakeries and grain mills.

~~Foods should be removed or covered during treatment.~~ Avoid contamination of food, food utensils or food processing surfaces. ~~Apply prescribed amounts of insecticide into cracks and crevices or voids using the injection wand taking care not to deposit the product into exposed surfaces or into the air!~~ Using the injection wand, apply into cracks & crevices, voids or insect harborage sites in areas such as: under edges of counter tops, tables, drawers, sinks; into voids of hollow equipment legs, booth benches, bases; around pipes and vents; and behind equipment. To avoid electric shock hazard do not apply into electric motors, food processing equipment, or appliances. Avoid depositing the product on exposed surfaces or spraying into the air.

Transportation Equipment - Apply into and along cracks and crevices in the different elements of construction and/or voids in storage or cargo compartments, around plumbing and utility fixtures, and under seats or other dark recessed areas. Do not apply into cracks/crevices or voids that contain any electrical wiring, vehicle operational controls or sensors. Avoid applying to point of runoff into adjacent compartments/areas. Do not use in cargo holds used for storage of unpackaged foods or feedstuffs.

Animal Facilities - Apply in cracks and crevices, along base boards, around doors and windows, under shelves; in areas such as storage, work or utility rooms. Do not contaminate any food or water supplies. In kennels, do not allow animals to re-occupy quarters until sprays have dried. Do not apply in areas (Example: zoo animal cages) where sanitation procedures could cause product to be discharged with washwater runoff. Dead insects should be swept up and disposed in trash container.

Manholes - Remove cover and apply around the underside of manhole rim and replace cover.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
 STORAGE: Store away from heat and open flames in an area inaccessible to children.

DISPOSAL: ~~Do not reuse empty can. Wrap can and place in trash.~~
 This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not smoke while using. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapors. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried. Note to Physician: Atropine by injection is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If on Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting. Foam can ignite. Keep away from sparks, pilot lights, and other flames, both during use and after use, until foam disappears. Do not use on copper or brass. Do not allow electrical contact, avoid shock hazard, position wand and direction of spray carefully. Do not apply directly into electronic equipment.
