The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Modify the statement in the Hazards to Humans section to read:

Causes skin irritation.
 - b. Delete "General Classification." This product has not been classified.
 - c. Update the Storage and Disposal section in accordance with the enclosed FR Notice 83-3.
 - d. Delete "without 2,4-D." Refer to the last comment in this letter.
2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

The amended formula and labeling supersede all previously accepted ones.
