STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes and under eyelids with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician immediately.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink egg whites, or gelatin, or water if these are not available. Drink large amounts of water. Call a physician immediately.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eye or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredients into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

This cleaner is a heavy duty cleaner and disinfectant designed for general purpose use where heavy duty cleaning and sanitizing is of prime importance.

GERMICIDAL CLEANER is recommended for cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing hard surfaces such as walls, floors, table tops, ceilings, in hospitals, schools, and in similar public places where cleanliness and bacterial control are important.

Not recommended for *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

DISINFECTION: For heavy duty cleaning and disinfecting and fungicidal activity against pathogenic fungi, use 4.5 ounces per gallon. For best results, use GERMICIDAL CLEANER with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, table tops and counters, maintaining a contact time of 10 minutes.

SANITIZATION: Use GERMICIDAL CLEANER for the sanitizing of previously cleaned food contact surfaces in restaurants, dairies and food processing equipment. Gross filth and heavy soil deposits must be removed prior to application of sanitizing solution. Prepare a sanitizing solution consisting of 8 ounces of GERMICIDAL CLEANER in 5 gallons of water (200 ppm of active quaternary). Apply this solution to surfaces with a mop, cloth by spraying or immersion, maintaining a minimum contact time of 1 minute. Wet all surfaces thoroughly. Drain solution from surface and allow to air dry. For extra heavy industrial cleaning and sanitizing, use a second application.

Do not mix with soap or anionic solutions. GERMICIDAL CLEANER is non-corrosive in use dilutions on inanimate hard surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place no lower in temperature than 50°F or higher than 120°F.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse empty container with water, then offer for reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Plastic containers may be disposed of in a sanitary landfill, incinerated, or if allowed by local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
