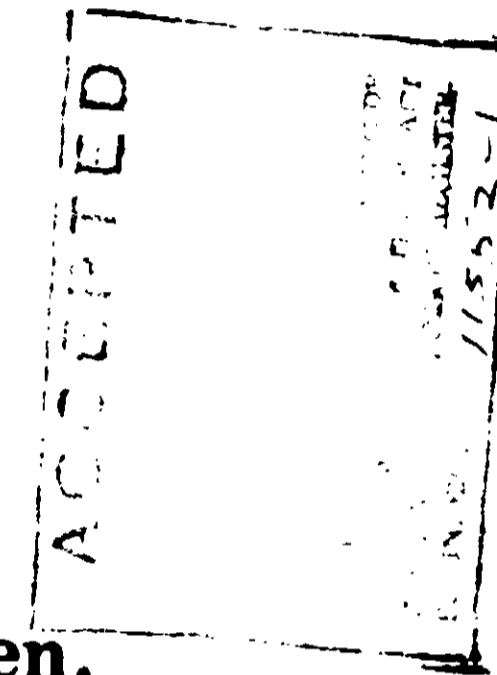

Note: Adios contains warfarin, an anticoagulant chemical that reduces the clotting ability of the blood. Upon repeated feedings, warfarin causes fatal hemorrhage in rats and mice. It also contains an antibacterial agent which inhibits the growth of bacteria that produce vitamin K, an antidote for the effects of warfarin.
Caution: Protect children, pets, and domestic animals

Directions List 3615
Rats: Place 1 to 2 Adios Pitch Packs next to burrows, in runways, or where rats are accustomed to feeding. Check these bait stations daily to assure an uninterrupted supply of bait for a period of not less than 12 days. Continue baiting until all signs of feeding have stopped.
Mice: Place 1 ounce of Adios in a shallow dry container next to burrows, in runways, or where mice are ac-

customed to feeding. It is recommended that Adios be placed at intervals of 8 to 12 feet. Check bait stations daily to assure an uninterrupted supply of Adios for a period of not less than 15 days.
Long Term Control: Bait continuously using Adios. Stale, damp, or moldy bait should be replaced with fresh bait promptly. Bait should be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, and domestic animals or in tamper-proof bait boxes.
