

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

1. Do not apply coating if difference between surface temperature and dew point is less than 5°F.
2. Flush equipment with Imperial #DL-6A Universal Solvent prior to use.
3. Stir material thoroughly before and thorough application. Do not thin except for workability, and then with no more than 10% volume with recommended solvent.
4. Remove all surface contaminants.
5. If using conventional spray, regulate air pressure: 60-80 psi to gun; 25-30 psi to pot. NOTE: hose length.
6. Apply material as a heavy, wet coat in even, parallel passes, overlapping each pass 50%.
7. Clean all equipment immediately after use with Imperial #DL-6A Universal Solvent.

**STATEMENT OF
