Subject: Label Amendment for Toxic Inerts
Sendran 20% Concentrate
EPA Registration No. 11556-2
Your Application Dated September 28, 1987

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Furgicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Add the Precautionary Statements heading to the paragraph that has such statements. Add "Wear a mask or respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health."
 - b. Add the appropriate Environmental Hazard and Physical and Chemical Hazard statements.
 - c. Add the Statement of Practical Treatment heading with appropriate first aid statements for each exposure route, in the following format:

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- d. Revise the Storage and Disposal statement per PR Notice 83-3. Add the statement "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance."

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

TO PHYSICIAN:

ANTIDOTE--Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning, even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Store in a cool place.
Do not store above 120°F.

In case of spillage, cover with absorbant such as soda ash clay, or sawdust.

Sweep up and dispose of properly.

Wash area thoroughly with strong lye solution.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
