

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hold container at a distance from the area to be treated that will permit even distribution of the dust. Keep lid closed when container is not in use.

## RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

ANIMAL	PARASITE	REMARKS
Cattle (Dairy & Beef)	Horn Flies Lice	DIRECT APPLICATION: Apply not more than 2 oz.* / animal. Dust evenly into the hair over the head, neck, shoulders, back and tailhead. Repeat as necessary. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat or milk as food.
Swine	Lice	DIRECT APPLICATION: Apply not more than 1 oz.* / animal as a uniform coat to the shoulders and back. Repeat as necessary, but not more than once every 10 days. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat as food.
		BEDDING TREATMENT: Apply 2 oz.* uniformly over each 30 square feet of fresh, dry bedding. Repeat as necessary, but not more than once every 10 days.
		DIRECT APPLICATION and BEDDING TREATMENT: In severe infestations, both individual animals and the bedding may be treated as directed above.

\*NOTE: 1 oz. of this material equals approximately three level tablespoonfuls.

## RESTRICTIONS

For external, insecticidal use on above specified animals only. Avoid contamination of feed, troughs, water, and water utensils. Provide thorough ventilation while dusting.

## CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not breathe dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling.
