DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CO-RAL 0.5% is suitable for direct application by any conventional dusting equipment, such as rotary or hand dusters, pump dusters, or by sprinkling from a can.

RECOMMENDED CO-RAL APPLICATIONS

ANIMAL	DISEASE	FORMULA CO-RAL 0.5%	REMARKS
Sheep	lice	(See Remarks)	<u>HAND DUSTER</u> - Apply 1 to 2 ozs. of dust per head. Work dust well into wool over entire body.
	lice (wool maggots)	(See Remarks)	<u>SPRINKLER</u> - Machine setting: 1 1/2 to 4 lbs. of dust per minute. Treatment rate: 50 to 100 sheep per minute. Repeat as necessary but not within 15 days of shearing.
Poultry	Northern Fowl Mite	(See Remarks)	<u>SPRINKLER APPLICATION</u> : Dust birds thoroughly, especially under wings and around vent. Supplementary control can be obtained by also treating litter and housing. Repeat as necessary but not more often than weekly.
	Northern Fowl Mite Poultry Red Mite	1	<u>HOUSE AND HOUSING TREATMENT</u> : Apply specified dosage per 70 sq. ft. of surface area to walls, ceiling, floor, roosts, nests, and adjacent areas, as well as per 20 sq. ft. of litter area. Force dust into all cracks and crevices. Repeat as necessary.
Dogs		(See Remarks)	<u>SPRINKLER</u> : Dust dogs thoroughly under the hair over the entire body. Repeat as necessary but not more often than weekly. Dogs' bedding should also be dusted to help prevent reinfestation.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not use on nursing puppies. Do not treat poultry within 10 days of vaccination or within 100 days of hatching.

Avoid contact with food, water, and water troughs.

Wear mask and goggles when dusting.

CAUTION

Avoid prolonged inhalation of dust. Wash face and eyes.

Do not allow child to feed or play. Keep out of reach of children.

If symptoms occur, obtain proper medical aid. Prolonged exposure will result in chest irritation and depression.

To relieve symptoms, nebulizer solution is an antidote. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
