Your Letter Dated September 10, 1990 and
Your Revised Labeling Received April 4, 1991

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. For all above listed products, make the following revisions:

- a. Under To Physician and Notice to Veterinarian, add "by injection" to the phrase "atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal."
- b. Under Storage and Disposal, revise the Pesticide Disposal Statement in accordance to PR Notice 83-3 as follows:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

2. For EPA Reg. No. 11556-4, make the following changes:
 - a. Under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, add **"or clothing."** at the end of the sentence, **"Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing."**
 - b. To the Use Restriction section, add the statement, **"Do not apply to sick, stressed, or convalescent animals."**
3. For EPA Reg. No. 11556-14, make the following changes:
 - a. Please note that the ingredient statement does not total to 100% but rather 100.5%.
 - b. The correct signal word for 1% dust products is **CAUTION** and not **WARNING**. Please make the correction as well as changing the precautionary statements under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing dusts. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing.
 - c. Add the following **Dust Bag Installation Instructions and Aid to Reduction of face fly populations** to the product label under the Directions for Use section as it appears on the label for Co-Ral® 1% Cattle Duster, EPA Reg. No. 11556-15.
4. For EPA Reg. No. 11556-15, make the following changes:
 - a. Please revise the **Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals** section as follows:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing dusts. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing.
 - b. Add as a footnote the following:

* Note: 1 ox. of this material equals approximately three levels tablespoons.
 - c. Add a **(2)** in front of the sentence beginning with **"The bags must be located..."** under the section on reducing face fly populations.
5. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure

for a further description of final printed labeling.

6. The revised Confidential Statement of Formulas (CSFs) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable. A copy of each have been inserted in your file for the subject products.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS/PRACTICAL TREATMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid breathing dusts.

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention if victim displays signs of poisoning.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

To Physician: Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater or rinsate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

Container Disposal: Completely empty the container by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Louse and Horn Fly Control:

Suspend CO-RAL 1% Cattle Duster in ^{areas} frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows CO-RAL 1% Cattle Duster may be suspended in the exit through which cows leave the milking barn. In all cases the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the topline of the cattle. *May the dispense bag so as not to*

Louse and Horn Fly Control and as an Aid in Reducing Face Fly Populations:

Suspend CO-RAL 1% Cattle Duster in the same manner as described under "Louse and Horn Fly Control" except as follows: (1) The bottom of the bags should be 18 to 24 inches from the ground to insure that the faces of the cattle will be dusted. *Apply 1 or 2 bags per animal daily* The bags must be located so the animals will be forced to use them daily.

Face Flies are able to travel over an area of several miles. Best results in reducing face fly populations are achieved when CO-RAL 1% Cattle Dusters are used on an area-wide basis.

INSTALLATION OF CO-RAL 1% CATTLE DUSTER:

Suspend the bags by inserting rope, chain or wire through the grommets at the top of the bag and attaching to an overhead structure or by hooking the grommets into hooks fastened to a stationary overhead 2 x 4 at the heights recommended for louse and horn fly or face fly control. In areas of frequent or heavy rainfall CO-RAL 1% Cattle Duster should be protected from the weather.

Install as many 10-pound (25- pound) CO-RAL 1% Cattle Dusters as necessary to lanes or other openings to assure proper dusting of the animals. After the bags are in place, pull the rip cord to allow the insecticide to fall into the bottom of the bag. When dust bags are provided on a free-choice basis, allow one 10-pound (25-pound) CO-RAL 1% Cattle Duster per 20 (50) animals.

No interval is required between treatment and slaughter or between treatment and use of milk as food.

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USE RESTRICTIONS

For external insecticidal use only on above-specified animals. Do not contaminate feed, troughs, water or water utensils. Provide thorough ventilation while dusting. Do not apply to sick, stressed or convalescent animals.
