

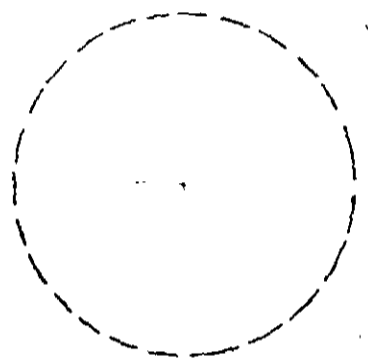

Cattle Grubs	10	SPRAY TREATMENT(S) Apply specified dosage in 4 gallons of water as high pressure spray to wet the surface of the animal. Repeat as necessary.
Horn Flies and Face Flies	9	CATTLE BACKRUBBERS Use specified dosage in 100-200% of body weight of animal. Saturate the back portion of the backrubber with this material. Rub into the back of the animal. Repeat as necessary. For daily use, saturate backrubber as needed. Note: For maximum effectiveness, the rubber should be completely saturated to permit the animal to rub the backrubber into the required areas between treatments.
Horn Flies	14	SPRAY TREATMENT(S) Apply specified dosage in 4 gallons of water for a complete wetting. Repeat as necessary.
Face Flies	27	SPRAY TREATMENT(S) Apply specified dosage in 4 gallons of water for a complete wetting. Repeat as necessary.

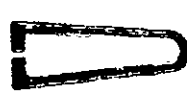
