The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. For all above listed products make the following label revisions:

- a. Under the "To Physician", revise the statement to read: "Atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal."
- b. Revise the Pesticide Disposal statement under the Storage and Disposal section as follows:

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label directions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

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- c. All end-use products in Toxicity Category I or II must bear the following worker protection clothing statements:

USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT DURING MIXING/LOADING, APPLICATION, REPAIR AND CLEANING OF MIXING, LOADING, AND APPLICATION EQUIPMENT, DISPOSAL OR THE PESTICIDE; long-sleeved shirt and long-legged pants; chemical resistant gloves; chemical resistant shoes (or chemical resistant shoe covers or chemical resistant boots). In addition, mixer/loader and dip tank workers must wear a chemical resistant apron and face shield or goggles, and a NIOSH/MSHA approved respiratory protection device.

3. For EPA Reg. No. 11556-19, add the following paragraph in the **REMARKS** section:

As face flies are able to travel over an area of several miles, best results in reducing face fly populations are achieved when Beef and Dairy Cattle Dusters are used on an area-wide basis.

4. For EPA Reg. No. 11556-24, make the following changes:
- On the front label panel include the pest which are controlled by the product.
 - Since this product is used to treat **sheep and goats**, you must add the following restriction:

For sheep and goats do not treat within 3 days of slaughtering.

5. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

6. The revised Confidential Statement of Formulas (CSFs) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable. A copy of each have been inserted in your file for the subject products.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid breathing dusts. ✓

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. ✓

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention if victim displays signs of poisoning.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

To Physician: Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater or rinsate. ✓

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedures.

Container Disposal: When the entire contents of the bag have been dispensed, dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, if allowed by state and local authorities.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Open nozzle by turning tip up. Keep nozzle tip closed (down) when not in use. Squeeze container to expel dust in short, light clouds. Hold nozzle 2 to 4 inches from area to be treated and apply light, even coat on and around this area.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

SCREW-WORMS: Treat infested wounds with light but thorough coverage. Be sure all parts of wound are completely coated. New wounds from docking, dehorning, etc. should be dusted at once with light uniform coat to avoid infestation. Repeat as necessary.

EAR TICKS: Dust into the ear and also treat the adjacent head area. Use short, sharp pressure on container. Repeat as necessary.

No interval is required between treatment of beef and dairy cattle and swine and use of meat or milk as food.

USE RESTRICTIONS

For external insecticidal use only on above-specified animals. Do not contaminate feed, troughs, water or water utensils. Provide thorough ventilation while dusting. Do not apply to sick, stressed or convalescent animals.
