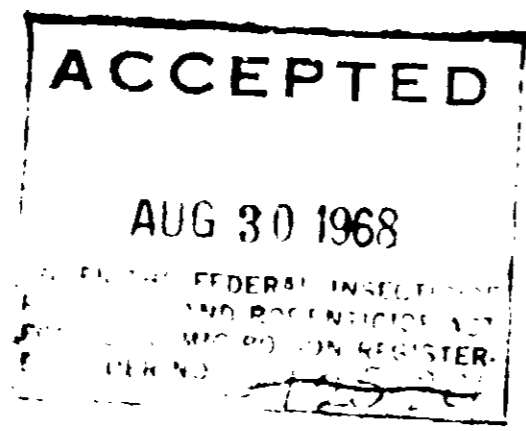

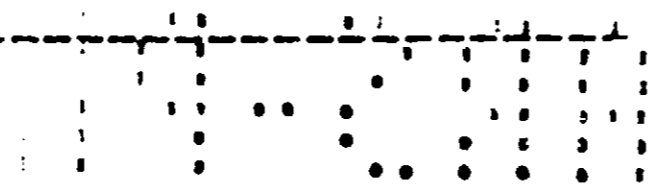
Effects of Poisoning: A sense of "tightness" in the chest. Sweating. Dilated pupils. Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea.

First Aid:

2421010 - administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses until symptoms subside to the point of tolerance.

Atropine inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nervous system. Give sorbitol. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases and persist, even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.
