Methyl carbamates inhibit cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning, even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

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This product must not be used to manufacture or formulate any pesticide product which is distributed or sold with a finger-operated or trigger-type sprayer, or to manufacture or formulate any manufacturing use or other pesticide product which is intended or may be lawfully used to manufacture or formulate any pesticide product which is distributed or sold with a finger-operated or trigger-type sprayer.
