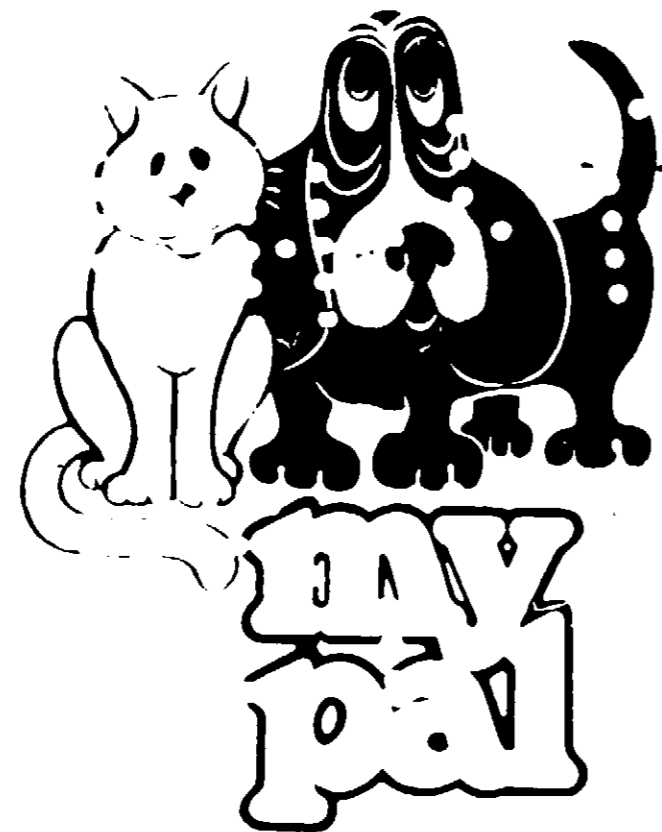

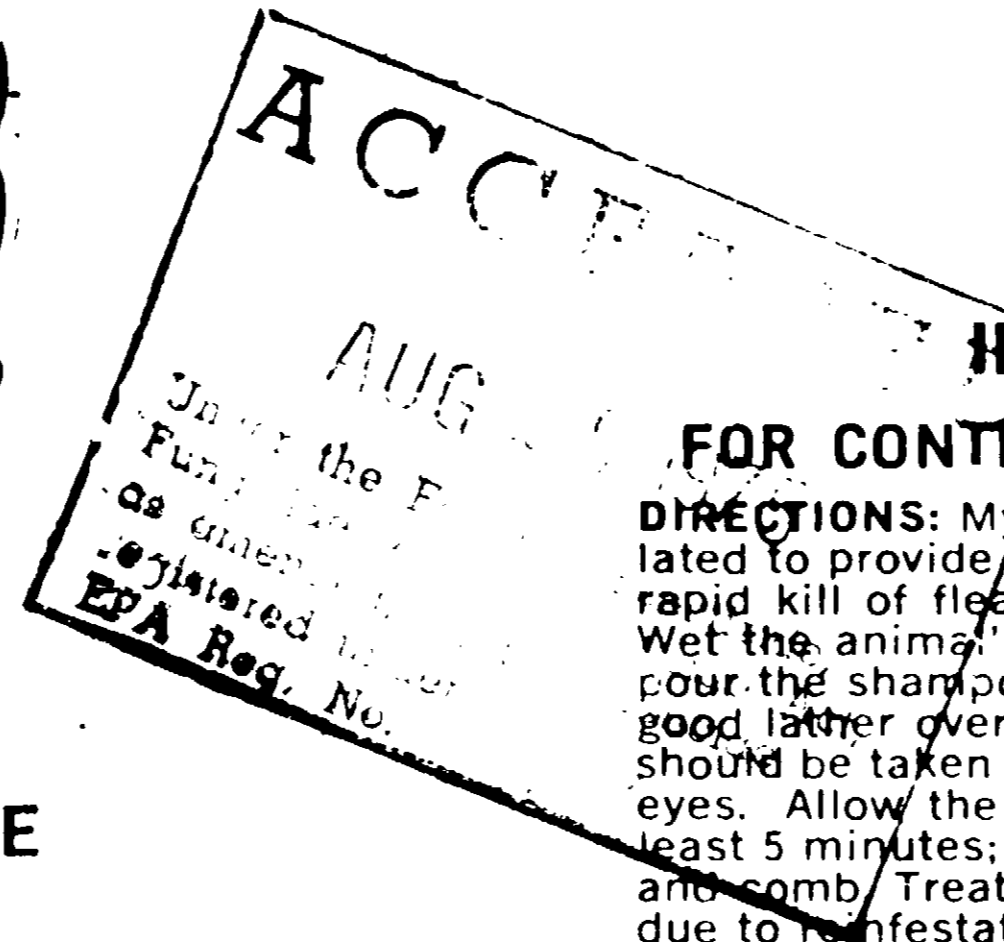

INSECTICIDE SHAMPOO

FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS ON DOGS AND CATS

DIRECTIONS: My Pal™ Insecticide Shampoo is especially formulated to provide both excellent cleansing of the skin and hair and rapid kill of fleas on dogs and cats.

Wet the animal's skin and hair thoroughly with warm water and pour the shampoo onto the coat. Use enough shampoo to form a good lather over the entire body and rub down to the skin. Care should be taken to avoid contact of the shampoo with the animal's eyes. Allow the lather to remain in contact with the skin for at least 5 minutes; then rinse well with warm water. Dry thoroughly and comb. Treatment may be repeated twice weekly if necessary due to reinfestation.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes. Excessive or prolonged contact of the product with the skin should be avoided. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after bathing animals. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs. Keep out of reach of children.

o-Isopropoxyphenyl methylcarbamate is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.
