The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Cyfluthrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. RESISTANCE-MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

For resistance management, Cutter Gold Insecticide Cattle Ear Tags contains a Group 3A insecticide. Any insect population may contain individuals naturally resistant to Cutter Gold Insecticide Cattle Ear Tags and other Group 3A insecticides. The resistant individuals may dominate the insect population if this group of insecticides are used repeatedly in the same sites. Appropriate resistance-management strategies should be followed.

Contact your local extension specialist advisors for any additional pesticide resistance-management and/or IPM recommendations for the specific pest problems in your area.

For the Control of Horn Flies, Gulf Coast Ticks, Spinose Ear Ticks, and as a Aid to Control Face Flies on Beef and Dairy Cattle (including lactating).

Apply tags when flies appear in spring. Attach one tag to each ear (two per head) with the Allflex™ Tagging system.

Disinfect pliers prior to use. Place male button onto pin until it projects through the tip.	Slide tag under the clip of the pliers by depressing the lever.	Position tag in the center portion of the front side of the ear.	Apply the tag between the second and third rib cartilage.

All animals in the herd should be tagged. Replace as necessary Tags remain effective for up to 5 months. Remove tags at the end of the fly season or before slaughter.

Continual exposure of horn flies to a single class of insecticide (e.g. pyrethroids or organophosphates) may lead to the development of resistance to that class of insecticide. In order to reduce the possibility of horn flies developing resistance it is important to rotate the class of insecticide used and/or the method of horn fly control on a seasonal basis.

Storage and Disposal:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in cool place in original container. Opened pouches containing ear tags should be resealed for storage.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Dispose of empty pouch in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by the state and local authorities. If burned stay out of smoke.
