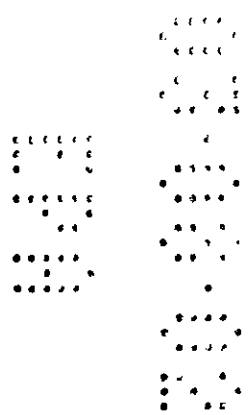

Enclosed with this application are five (5) copies of final printed labels for Bayer's Advantage[®] 9 for Cats product (EPA Reg. No. 11556-116). This label is for a new package size (1 tube). The revision is being made by Notification as per PR Notice 98-10 which allows for a change in package size under section II.B "Changes in Packaging and Related Labeling Statements." The enclosed label is identical to the currently approved labels for the 4-tube and 6-tube package sizes for Advantage 9 for Cats. The only change from the existing label is the net contents statement for the 1-tube package, specifically "One 0.4 mL Tube". Except for the net contents statement, no other changes have been made to the label.

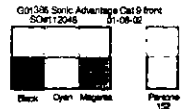
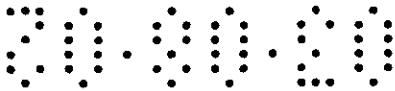

1. Use only on cats. Do not use on other animals.
2. Remove one applicator tube from the package.

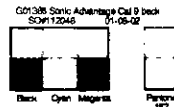
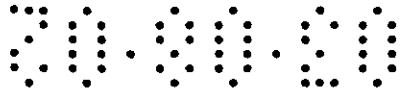
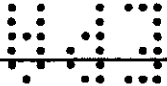


3. Hold applicator tube in an upright position. Pull cap off tube.
4. Turn the cap around and place other end of cap back on tube.

5. Twist cap to break seal, then remove cap from tube.



6. Part the hair in the base of the skull until the skin is visible. Place the tip of the tube on the skin and squeeze the tube twice to expel the entire contents of the tube directly on the skin. Do not get this product in your pet's eyes or mouth. The product is bitter tasting and salivation may occur for a short time if the cat licks the product immediately after treatment. Treatment at the base of the skull will minimize the opportunity for the cat to lick the product.
7. Discard empty tube as described in Storage and Disposal.
