The subject labels have been reviewed and will be acceptable if the following claim modification is made on each of the labels. Delete The successive feeding activities....reduces the incidents of this condition." The following statement may be used as a replacement:

"The successive feeding activities of fleas on pets may elicit a hypersensitivity skin disorder known as flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). Treatment of pets with Advantage rapidly kills fleas and may reduce the incidence of this condition."


