of Statement on Pre-Existing Pupae.

Submissions were received at EPA on December 16, 1997

Dear Mr. McNamara,

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The amended labels referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, have undergone review and are conditionally acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Revise the use on puppies to a minimum age of seven weeks or older.
- 2. Provide EPA with data on the incidence of adverse reactions in puppies, kittens, dogs and cats, after six months of relabeled product being available in veterinary clinics. Data should specify breeds where applicable.

Stamped copies of the conditionally approved labels are enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Use only on dogs. Do not use on other animals.
- 2. Remove applicator tube from the package.
- 3. Hold applicator tube in an upright position. Pull cap off tube.



4. Turn the cap around and place other end of cap back on tube.




5. Twist cap to break seal, then remove cap from tube.





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6. The dog should be standing for easy application. The entire contents of the Advantage® tube should be applied evenly to three or four spots on the top of the back from the shoulder to the base of the tail. At each spot, part the hair until the skin is visible. Place the tip of the tube on the skin and gently squeeze to expel a portion of the solution on the skin. Do not apply an excessive amount of solution at any one spot that could cause some of the solution to run off the side of the dog.



Do not get this product in your pet's eyes or mouth.

7. Discard empty tube as described in Storage and Disposal.

The successive feeding activity of fleas on pets frequently elicits a hypersensitivity skin disorder known as flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). Treatment of pets with Advantage® rapidly kills fleas and reduces the incidence of this condition.

Advantage® kills 98-100% of the existing fleas on pets within 12 hours. Reinfesting fleas are killed within 2 hours with protection against further flea infestation lasting at least four (4) weeks. Pre-existing pupae in the environment may continue to emerge for six (6) weeks or longer depending upon the climatic conditions.

Larval flea stages in the pet's surroundings are killed following contact with an Advantage® treated pet.
