APPLICATION FOR PESTICIDE AMENDMENT

Enclosed for Agency acceptance are five (5) copies each of two draft labels (4-pack and 6-pack sizes), dated January 8, 2001, for Advantage 55 for Dogs, EPA Reg. No. 11556-120. Please note that the 4-pack and 6-pack labels are identical except for the net contents statement. The enclosed draft labeling is based on the label which the Agency accepted on June 25, 1998 as well as minor changes made by Notification on September 13, 1999.

The proposed changes to the Advantage 55 for Dogs label are based on PR Notice 2001-1 which requests voluntary changes to the First Aid statement. The only label changes needed for compliance are list below. Please note, all other existing label text is already in compliance with the PR Notice.

Specifically, the following are the changes made to the existing EPA-accepted labeling:

Previous labeling contained the First Aid statement:

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

With the enclosed draft labeling, Bayer proposes to change the First Aid statement to the exact wording used in PR Notice 2001-1:

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 – 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
