

- 2. Remove one applicator tube from the package.



- 3. Hold applicator tube in an upright position. Pull cap off tube
- 4. Turn the cap around and place other end of cap back on tube.
- 5. Twist can to break seal, then remove can from tube.



- 6. The dog should be standing for easy application. The entire contents of the Advantage tube should be applied evenly to three or four spots on the top of the back from the shoulder to the base of the tail. At each spot, part the hair until the skin is visible. Place the tip of the tube on the skin and gently squeeze to expel a portion of the solution on the skin. Do not apply an excessive amount of solution at any one spot that could cause some of the solution to run off the side of the dog.
- 7. Discard empty tube as described in Storage and Disposal

The successive feeding activity of fleas on pets may elicit a hypersensitivity skin disorder known as flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). Treatment of pets with Advantage rapidly kills fleas and may reduce the incidence of this condition.
