Section II – Explanation:

Bayer HealthCare, Animal Health Division, is notifying the Agency that we plan to produce the product in a third package size, a single tube pack (1-pack), in addition to the current 4- and 6-pack configurations. This is noted on page one of this application form. The packaging and labeling scheme for this size is identical to that used for the other two pack sizes of this product, except for the number of tubes contained.

We are also notifying the Agency, pursuant to PR Notice 98-10, that we will be adding the following optional text to final printed labeling of the appropriate size product, as needed:

["Sample – Not for Resale"]

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46 and no other changes have been proposed for the labeling or the confidential statement of formula for this product. Bayer understands that it is a violation of 18 U.S. C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. Bayer further understands that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and Bayer may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

- 2. Remove applicator tube from the package.

- 3. Hold applicator tube in an upright position. Pull cap off tube.
- 4. Turn the cap around and place other end of cap back on tube.
- 5. Twist cap to break seal, then remove cap from tube.
- 6. The dog should be standing for easy application. The entire contents of the K9 Advantix® tube should be applied evenly to three or four spots on the top of the back from the shoulder to the base of the tail. At each spot, part the hair until the skin is visible. Place the tip of the tube on the skin and gently squeeze to expel a portion of the solution on the skin. Do not apply an excessive amount of solution at any one spot that could cause some of the solution to run off the side of the dog.

7. Discard empty tube as described in Storage and Disposal.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

Kills fleas which may cause flea allergy dermatitis (FAD).

K9 Advantix[®] kills existing fleas on dogs within 12 hours. Reinfesting fleas are killed within 2 hours with protection against further flea infestation lasting four (4) weeks. Pre-existing pupae in the environment may continue to emerge for six (6) weeks or longer depending upon the climatic conditions.

Larval flea stages in the dog's surroundings are killed following contact with a K9 Advantix[®] treated dog.

K9 Advantix[®] is waterproof and remains effective following a shampoo treatment, swimming or after exposure to rain or sunlight.

Monthly treatments are required for optimal control and prevention of fleas and ticks.
