Dear Jennifer Schofield:

The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable under FIFRA Section 3(c)(5) subject to the following conditions:

- 1. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration/registration review of your product under FIFRA when the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or the Agency) requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. This registration is time-limited and expires five years from the date of this letter. Elanco US Inc. may request extension of the time-limited registration, or removal of the expiration date. An amendment request for these changes must be submitted at least one year prior to the expiration date and is subject to EPA Review.
- 3. Elanco US Inc. must submit annual enhanced incident reports and annual sales information in doses sold for this product in the EPA developed templates found at <u>https://www.epa.gov/pesticides/use-standardized-templates-report-pet-spot-incidentsconclusion-pilot-and-implementation</u>. The data are to be provided no later than the end of the first quarter of the following year (e.g., 2023 data no later than 31 Mar 2024). Please flag any Confidential Business Information as such. Submit enhanced incident reporting and annual sales information to the Product Manager's attention in addition to your regular reporting of incidents through electronic submission.
- 4. Elanco US Inc. must submit an annual report, similar to a modified Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Annual Periodic Drug Experience Report, which provides an update on stewardship efforts and analysis of safety information collected the preceding

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year. This additional analysis must be submitted together with Elanco US Inc.'s annual submission of detailed case data (Item #3) and will include:

- a. Update on execution of stewardship efforts.
- b. Brief summary of the incidence rates of reports of adverse effects during the preceding year.
- c. Detailed analysis of any serious adverse effects that have increased in frequency during the preceding year.
- d. Overall evaluation of the benefit-risk profile of the product, taking into account adverse effect data and any other new or emerging safety information.
- 5. Elanco US. Inc. must develop and implement additional efforts regarding case follow-up, referrals, and necropsies as medically indicated. Annually, Elanco US Inc. must review and update training materials, frequency of training, and technical solutions for collecting and providing data related to the pets involved in adverse event (AE) reports for all Elanco US Inc. staff responsible for taking in these data. Elanco US Inc. will, to the fullest extent possible, include the following information for each AE:
  - a. Pre-existing medical conditions (e.g., hypothyroidism, diabetes), including previous history of reported condition.
  - b. Medications concomitantly administered.
  - c. Pet's prior experience with the product.
  - d. Pet health status

Elanco US Inc. must report on these efforts one year from the registration and has committed to continuing these efforts moving forward.

- 6. Elanco US Inc. must develop and implement a communications initiative to ensure the US veterinary community is informed of risks and benefits associated with use of pesticides in pet products, including Seresto, and the importance of reporting AEs. Those communications will include, at a minimum:
  - a. A discussion of pesticide products in pet health risks and AE reporting (including phone numbers relevant to reporting for Elanco US Inc. products).
  - b. A reminder that a Post Approval Experience (PAE) section is now on the label, including reported adverse events as listed below, and the owner is recommended to remove the collar and consult their veterinarian if these symptoms occur.
    - i. AEs in dogs are listed in decreasing order of reporting frequency: pruritus (itchy skin), vomiting, lethargy, behavioral disorders, application site reactions (dermatitis, inflammation, eczema, alopecia or lesions), anorexia, hyperactivity, muscle tremor, vocalization, convulsion, ataxia (problems with balance and coordination).
  - c. An update on outcomes of EPA's Seresto review
  - d. Elanco US Inc. will utilize the following items for delivery:
    - i. Submission of an educational article to a veterinary trade publication (e.g., DVM360, Vet Practice News)
    - ii. Submission of information to the Veterinary Information Network (VIN)
    - iii. Letter to pet health Doctors of Veterinary Medicine (DVMs)
    - iv. Email "blast" to drive DVMs to a webpage

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- v. Elanco US Inc. web content with Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for DVMs
- vi. White paper which can be accessed online or sent out upon request by our pharmacovigilance (PV) call center

Elanco US Inc. must report on these efforts one year from the registration and provide a commitment to continuing these efforts moving forward. EPA may make recommendations to improve the outreach efforts after the 1-year review.

- 7. Elanco US Inc. must evaluate and summarize known characteristics of the release mechanism of the collar including testing performed to assess performance.
  - a. Elanco US Inc. must assess potential modifications of the release mechanism to optimize performance without compromise to collar retention under normal conditions of use.
  - b. Elanco US Inc. must report on these efforts one year from the registration and provide a commitment to continuing these efforts moving forward.
- 8. If, after formal consultation with the appropriate Service(s), additional modifications are identified in the Service's Biological Opinion(s) for imidacloprid, EPA will notify Elanco US Inc. in writing consistent with the terms in the Biological Opinion of any necessary required changes. Elanco US Inc. must submit an application for amendment incorporating any required changes, including amended labels, consistent with the timeline specified in EPA's notification.\_Alternatively, Elanco US Inc. may respond by submitting a request for voluntary cancellation of this product. If Elanco US Inc. fails to comply with this term, Elanco US Inc. has agreed in prior written acceptance of these terms that EPA may cancel the registration under an expedited process under FIFRA 6(e).

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

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Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these terms. If you fail to satisfy these terms, EPA will consider appropriate regulatory action including, among other things, cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6, including cancellation under FIFRA section 6(e). #### HOW TO APPLY

One collar per dog to be fastened around the neck.


Remove collar from protective bag directly before use. Unroll collar and make sure that there are no remnants from the plastic connectors inside the collar.

Insert end of the collar through the buckle. Adjust the collar around the dog's neck without tightening it too tight or leaving it too loose. As a guide, fit 2 fingers comfortably between the collar and the neck. Pull excess collar through the loop(s). Cut collar to a length no greater than [1][one][an] inch (2 cm) beyond the loop(s) unless it is on a growing puppy where some additional length may be needed for adjustment as the animal grows.

[After application of the collar, three reflector clips may be fixed permanently to the collar to increase the animal's visibility in the dark. Take the clips out of the bag. The clips should be evenly distributed on the non-overlapping part of the collar. The clips are correctly applied when a clicking sound is heard. Kills fleas which may cause flea allergy dermatitis (FAD) or flea bite hypersensitivity (FBH).

[PNR 1427 Insecticide][ABN][This product][The collar] kills existing fleas on dogs 24 hours after initial application of the collar. After 24 hours, any new fleas on the dog are killed within 2 hours with protection against further flea infestation lasting eight (8) months. Pre-existing pupae in the environment may continue to emerge for six (6) weeks or longer depending upon the climatic conditions. Treat the dog's living areas with a product approved for home use [such as the Elanco line of home treatments].
