As allowed by PR Notice 98-10, Bayer HealthCare LLC Animal Health Division is adding an alternate package size and additional optional labeling. The alternate package size will include two fully labeled 12.5 pound containers of bulk dust as well as an application bag. Full labeling will be on the new outer package identical to the individual packages with the optional text stating that an application bag is included. We have also updated the EPA Registration number and revised the condition of sale and warranty statement as the label has not been converted into the Bayer format after the product was acquired from KMG-Bernuth in March of 2012.

Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders.

For lactating dairy cows, bags may be suspended in the exit through which cows leave the milking barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the topline of the cattle. For reduction of face flies, the bags must be located so the animals will be forced to use them daily and hung at the height to insure that the faces of the cattle will be dusted.

Horn Flies, Lice: Direct Application: Apply 2.0 ounces of dust per animal by shaker can over the head, neck shoulders, back and tailhead. Repeat as necessary.

POULTRY

Northern Fowl Mites: Direct Application: Apply not more than 11b/100 birds, directing dust to thoroughly cover vent area.

SWINE

Lice on Swine: Direct Application: Apply not more than 1 ounce* (3 level tablespoors) per nead as a uniform coat to the head, shoulders and back by use of a shaker can. Repeat as necessary, but not more often than once every ten days.

Update Label with Bayer EPA Reg. No. and optional text.

In Severe infestations, both individual animals and the bedding may be treated as directed above.

Do not ship animals for slaughter within 5 days of last treatment.

*Note 1 ounce of this material equals approximately three level tablespoonfuls.
