ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically permitted and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems with out previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. IN CASE OF FIRE

Use CO₂ or dry chemical for small fires; alcohol-type aqueous foam-forming foam or water spray for large fires. Use water spray to cool fire exposed vessels and structures. Wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and complete personal protective equipment when potential for exposure to vapor or products of combustion exists.

IN CASE OF SPILL

Clean up immediately. Place leaking containers in well-ventilated area. Eliminate ignition sources. To clean up spill, flush area sparingly with water or use an absorbent. Avoid runoff into storm sewers and ditches leading to natural waterways. Neutralize with ammonium hydroxide or sodium sulfite. NOTE: This reaction is reversible.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Inhaled, remove to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.
