Your Amendment Application Dated April 30, 1987

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. The ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS statement must be revised to read as follows:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

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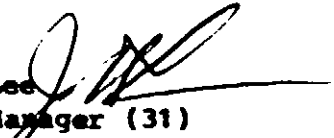
- b. The words "Danger" and "Poison" and the "Skull and Crossbones" must be in red on a contrasting background on the front panel.
- c. The correct product name of this product is "37% Formaldehyde, 12-15% Methanol." If you wish to use the product name of "37% Formaldehyde Solution 12% Methanol" you must submit an Amendment Application for this change. (Note that on item 6, the product name of your Amendment Application dated April 30, 1987, the name "Formaldehyde Solution 37%, 1% Methanol" is given which is not correct for EPA Registration No. 11558-10.)

- 3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Corrosive Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. When handling formaldehyde solutions wear goggles, neoprene or rubber gloves and impervious clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Observe conditions listed in Storage section below. Use full-face NIOSH-approved formaldehyde or acid gas cartridge or canister respirator within use limitations of these devices in all other situations. Use self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Treated fluid should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Use CO₂ or dry chemical for small fires; alcohol-type aqueous film forming foam or water spray for large fires. Use water spray to cool fire exposed vessels and structures. Wear self contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and complete personal protective equipment when potential for exposure to vapor or products of combustion exists.

Clean up immediately. Place leaking containers in well-ventilated area. Eliminate ignition sources. To clean up spill, flush area sparingly with water or use an absorbent. Avoid runoff into storm sewers and ditches leading to natural waterways. Neutralize with ammonium hydroxide or sodium sulfite. NOTE: This reaction is reversible.
